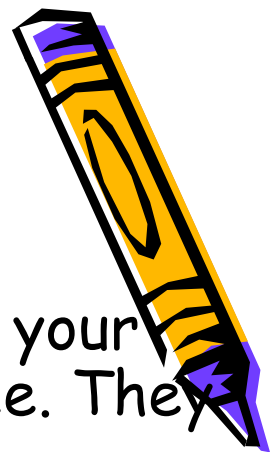


- This is a transitional year, not just a "review" year.

- Please keep absences to a minimum. We cover an immense amount of content each day. Please try to make appointments as late as you can.

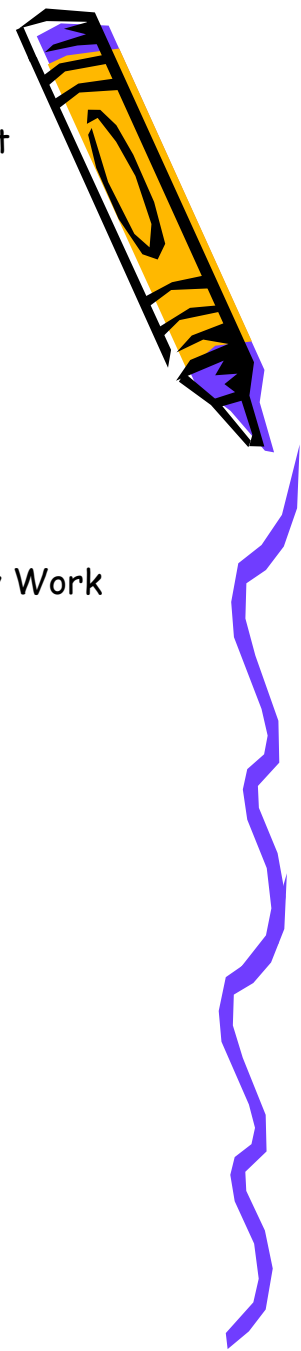


Our Daily Routine

The meaning of the acronym CHAMP

- o C-Check Your Feet
- o H-Hands to Yourself
- o A-Always Act Respectfully
- o M-Make Good Decisions
- o P-Pay Attention



How does a CHAMP look in the Bathroom?

- o Check your Feet-Students will keep their feet on the ground
- o Hands to Yourself
- o Always Act Respectfully-Students will use toilets and sinks appropriately.
- o Make Good Decisions-Students will wash their hands.
- o Pay Attention-Students will pay attention to their actions, not the actions of others.

How does a CHAMP look in the Hallway?

- o Check your feet-Students will walk on the second tile.
- o Hands to Yourself-Hands by your side.
- o Always Act Respectfully-Keep voices off while others are learning.
- o Make Good Decisions-Follow all directions given by the teacher.
- o Pay Attention-Pay attention to where they are going in the hallway.

How does a CHAMP look in the Cafeteria?

- o Check your Feet-Students keeping their feet to themselves at the table.
- o Hands to Yourself-Students only touching their food.
- o Always Act Respectfully-Saying "Please" and "Thank You" in the lunch line, picking up trash, and talking quietly.
- o Make Good Decisions-Follow all directions given by lunch monitor.
- o Pay Attention-Students will walk towards the lunch line and line up after lunch appropriately.

When students have a growth mindset, they:

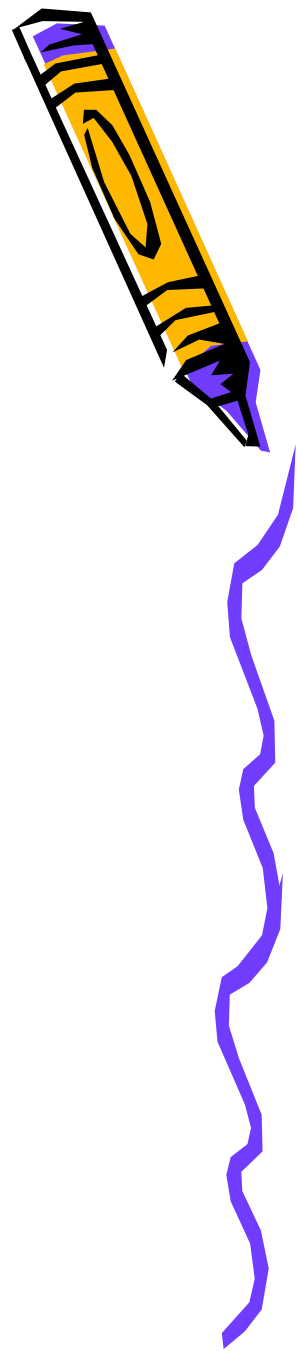
- Understand that intelligence can be developed.

Through **effort**, the right **strategies** and **getting help** from others, you can achieve more than you thought you could.

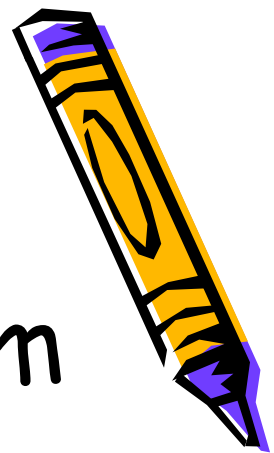

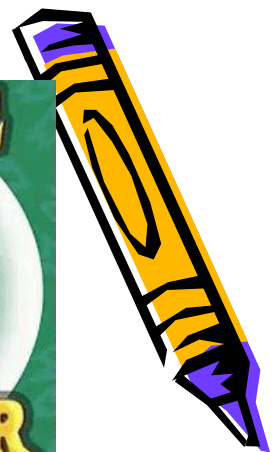
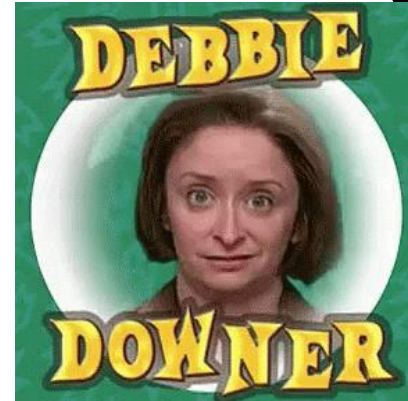


A Little More about Behavior...

Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Each and every one of us is responsible for our own actions. Remember, every action has a consequence-both the good and the bad.

The school wide behavior plan will be enforced in my classroom. Students that misbehave will face the following consequences: he/she will first be given a warning, second he/she will be sent to another teacher's room if the misbehavior continues, next will be an **infraction/parent phone call**, a **second infraction**, and a **third infraction will result in an office referral**.

- Taneka Mason is your child's school counselor this year.



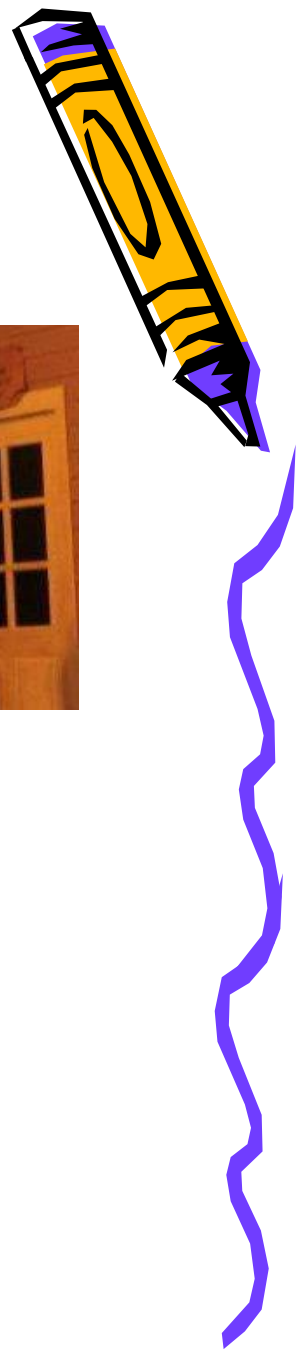
Transportation
